

SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

Please submit your property using our electronic submission form. Emailed images will not be accepted.

Shoot single, high-resolution images in landscape (horizontal) orientation. If using a phone to photograph, select “actual size” when sending to ensure adequate quality.

Shoot the interior and exterior of the property.

For exteriors, take a photo of the front of your property from across the street and a reverse from the front door to show the property and its immediate surroundings. Use the same rationale for the back of the property. Take photos of the street in both directions as well.

For interiors, duplicate the experience of someone walking through the building. Shoot the rooms to give a sense of space: take a photo at one end of each room, off from the corner, and shoot a reverse from the opposite side of the room.

20-30 photos are adequate for most locations. We reserve the right to select the best among the submitted photos and delete those which are redundant or of poor quality.

WE CANNOT ACCEPT:

- Photos that are out of focus
- Properties listed for sale
- Photos with date stamps or watermarks
- Wide-angle photography
- Images that have been overly colour corrected or had filters applied
- Photos that focus on decorative details or people

Please attempt to adhere to the above guidelines. They are in place to ensure your submission will meet our minimum standards required for inclusion in the database.

Your file will be available for viewing, printing and electronic distribution by location professionals worldwide seeking the perfect locations for their projects. They will contact you directly if they are interested in using your property for their production.
